1. Scope

This policy covers the topic of parental supervision of children.

2. Definition

TPIBC requires that children under the age of 14 be accompanied to church by a parent or adult guardian.

3. Roles and responsibilities

- a. Parents/guardians: responsible for the safety and welfare of their children during all unsupervised activities.
- b. Children's worship leaders/children's Sunday school teachers: responsible for children's welfare during worship/class time. However, parents/guardians should identify themselves to the children's worship leaders/teachers and ensure that they can be contacted immediately should such a need arise.

4. Other points

- a. TPIBC activities take place within the Tai Po Baptist Primary school. The church is only a tenant of the school.
- b. TPIBC has a duty of care to the School to leave the premises clean and tidy after use on Sunday and to respect school property.
- c. The *Refreshments Fellowship Time* (between the worship service and Sunday school) is unsupervised, so parents/guardians are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of their children during this time.
- d. Parents: please instruct your children NOT to run in the common areas as there are many elderly around (who are attending the Chinese worship service).
